I am in receipt of your records request dated October 16, 2016 requesting settlement agreements entered into by our School District with parents and guardians, from January 1, 2011 through today, relative to the provision of special education services and/or educational placement(s) for students with disabilities, redacted of all personally identifying information.

I would be happy to provide the information to you. However, I must request a fee from you for the search, segregation, preparation and review of the records as allowed under M.G.L Chapter 66, Section 10. Due to the confidential nature of this request, we estimate that it would take at least 3 hours per settlement agreement to research and prepare the information and we have 2 agreements. The lowest paid person eligible to retrieve and compile this data, currently makes \$25.38 per hour. Keep in mind that we will require that the actual cost of the production of the documents be paid before I can provide you with the documents. If you wish to proceed with the records request, kindly forward to the district the payment of \$152.28 to cover the above estimated costs. If, after receipt of the estimated fee, the actual fee increases above the estimate I will provide you with another estimate to complete the production of the documents that must be paid before I release the information to you.
