Dear Mr. Teixeira:

I am in receipt of your request for copies of special education settlement agreements entered into by the Walpole Public School District since January 1, 2011. These educational records, unredacted, are exempt from the state's public records law under c. 4, §7, Twenty-sixth (a) and (c). First, the records are exempt because they are confidential under both state and federal student records laws and regulations. Second, they are exempt due to their very personal nature.

In order to render them public records, they will have to be redacted of all personally identifiable information. The lowest hourly-rate of an employee capable of collecting the records and then redacting it is \$25.00 per hour. We estimate that the project will take 21 hours to complete.
