Dear Mr. Schafer:

I have received the petition of Jorge Teixeira appealing the response of the Abington Public Schools (School) to a request for public records. G. L. c. 66, § 10A; see also 950 C.M.R. 32.08(1). Specifically, Mr. Teixeira requested "Abington Public Schools' Settlement Agreements, from 2014 through today." The School provided a response on January 3, 2020, indicating there are no responsive documents to his request. Unsatisfied with the School's response, Mr. Teixeira petitioned this office and this appeal, SPR20/0075, was opened as a result.

While this appeal was pending, the School provided a supplemental response to Mr. Teixeira on January 22, 2020 indicating there were no settlements since 2014 and inquiring if there was anything else he was requesting.

***Conclusion***

On January 22, 2020, Mr. Teixeira was asked if he wished to continue his appeal in light of the School's response, and he indicated he did not. Accordingly, I will consider this appeal closed.
